

## **Survey results to date (inadequate sample size so these are for information only)**

- Vote in Park 52%
- Taxes:
  - Have reviewed assessment card: 70%
  - Think assessment is wrong: 26%
  - Think Town-by-town assessment is wrong: 68%
  - Think seasonal and permanent people should be equally assessed: 84%
  - Think assessment increases should be capped at CPI until sale: 90%
  - Believe “intrinsic” values should be in State land assessments: 68%
  - Believe State should directly fund education: 79%
  - Support “circuit breaker” bill: 47%, oppose it: 16%
  - Support 4% cap: 44%; oppose it: 11%
  - Want comprehensive tax reform vs stop-gap measures: 84%
  - Support use fees to relieve property tax: 58%, opposed: 21%
- Water quality
  - Want better State-wide standards: 79%
  - Think road salt is a serious problem needing addressing: 89%
  - Want a Park-wide road-management plan: 84%
  - State should monitor water quality in the Park and produce a master plan: 100%
  - State should support local storm water and sewerage infrastructures: 89%
- Invasives:
  - State should survey all waters and plan for controls: 85%
  - Eradication and control should be paid for by the State: 95%
  - Boats should have mandatory inspections before re-launch in pristine waters: 90%
- Enforcement
  - Zoning reg’s are clearly written and enforced: 66% disagree
  - Water quality reg’s are clearly written and enforced: 61% disagree
  - Setback and similar codes are clearly written and enforced: 55% disagree
  - Septic similar codes are clearly written and enforced: 61% disagree
  - Violations are vigorously pursued: 78% disagree
  - Land use codes should be better enforced: 72% agree
  - DEC does an effective enforcement job: 16% agree, 33% disagree
  - APA is an overreaching bureaucracy: 16% agree, 79% disagree
  - APA needs tighter reg’s and better enforcement: 58% agree
- Zoning
  - Support a Park-wide retail limit: 84%
  - Want Park-wide Jet-ski controls: 73%
  - Want strengthened land-use codes: 94%
  - Sprawl is a problem: 95%
  - Want corridors for ATVs and Snowmobiles: 68%
- Government reform:
  - Want a single Park commissioner: 63%
  - Want unfunded mandates rolled back: 89%
  - Support consolidation of services: 100%
  - No development without master plan: 89% agree
- Forest Preserve:
  - Want cap on forest preserve size: 33% for vs. 33% opposed
  - The current balance (50/50) is close to right: 28% agree, 17% disagree
  - Trading Park for private lands should be permitted: 63% agree

- Economic development:
  - Support the Community store: 63% with 10% strongly opposed
  - Support projects like the Carousel: 58%
  - Believe more middle income housing is needed: 68% with 10% strongly opposed
- Broadband
  - Have it: 78%
  - Support tax dollar use to expand it: 67%
  - Would pay more for improved service: 63%
  - Would pay more for faster service: 42%
- Energy
  - Want public funding for alternative energy: 68%
  - Want reg's to encourage conservation: 94%
  - Will pay more for "clean" energy: 74%
  - APA reg's should be relaxed for wind farms: 33% agree, 28% disagree
- Other
  - 2/3 will work for AdkAction.org in vetting candidates, etc.
  - 27% will actively campaign
  - 60% will write letters
  - 93% will contribute to us
  - 20% will participate in the management of AdkAction.org
