



#### HABITAT FOR HUMANITY, A SNAPSHOT

- Capital District Region
  - Completed 130 homes since 1988 including multi-family, mixed use, and row buildings (~4/year)
- City of Syracuse
  - Completed 70 homes since 1984 (2/year)
- Mohawk Valley (GMVLB Catchment Area)
  - Otsego County
    - Completed 34 homes since 1989 (~1/year)
  - Oneida County
    - Completed 22 homes since 1990 (~0.75/year)
  - Herkimer County
    - Completed 9 single-family projects since 1999 (~0.5/year)
  - Montgomery County
    - Completed 1 single-family project past decade (~0.1/year)
  - Schoharie County
    - No local Habitat affiliate (0/year)





### Annualized Revenue Projection
